<p>Brief Summary: The Inter-School Storytelling Competition will be held on 27 April 2026. It will be open to students of Grades 7 and 8. Participants can choose any theme, including folklore from India or around the world. Each story should last 5–6 minutes and be presented in English. Minimal props or costumes may be used. Schools must register their participants (one from each grade) by the deadline.</p> <p><u>Guidelines for participation:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Eligibility: Open to students in Grades 7 and 82. Theme: Participants may choose their own themes, including folklore in India or any part of the world3. Duration: Each story must be between 5-6 minutes long4. Language: Stories will be presented in English only	

5. Props and Costumes: Minimal props or costumes may be used to enhance storytelling, but they are optional

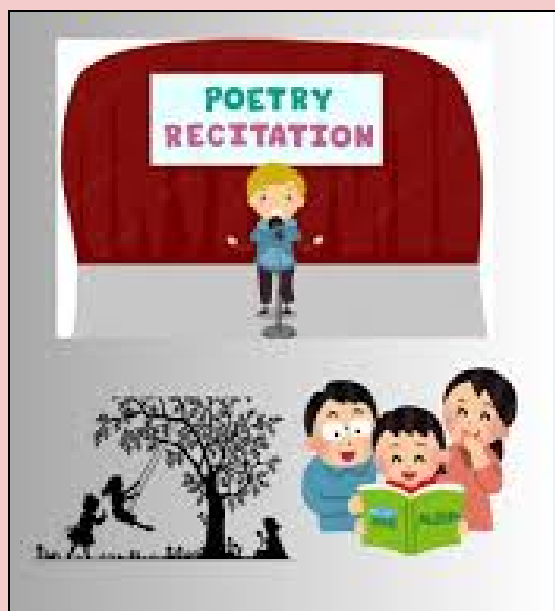
6. Judging Criteria:

- Clarity of Expression
- Creativity and Originality
- Adherence to Time Limit
- Use of Body Language and Voice Modulation
- Overall Dramatic Presentation

7. Registration:

- Registration is required through respective schools by the designated deadline.
- Each school may send a maximum of 2 students (one child each from grade 7 and 8)

8. Decision of Judge: The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

<p>Brief Summary:</p> <p>Inter-school English poetry recitation competition for Classes V and VI will be held on 27 April 2026 with 2 participants (one from each class). The theme can be Nature, Colour, or Peace, and poems should be by Modern or Romantic poets.</p> <p>Content must be respectful, age appropriate, from a published source, and aligned with the chosen theme. The time limit is 1 minute 20 seconds for Class 5 and 1 minute 50 seconds for Class 6, including a short introduction. All rules must be followed strictly to ensure fair participation.</p> <p>Inter-School Storytelling Competition Guidelines:</p>	

1. Theme

- Nature/Colour/Peace
- Poet (Modern/Romantic)

2. Content:

- Respectful and age appropriate
- Should not hurt any sentiments
- Must be from a published source
- Should be related to the selected theme

3. Time Limit:

- Class 5: 1 min 20 sec (with short introduction)
- Class 6: 1 min 50 sec (with short introduction)

4. Criteria for Judgement

- Choice of poem
- Fluency
- Expression
- Voice Modulation
