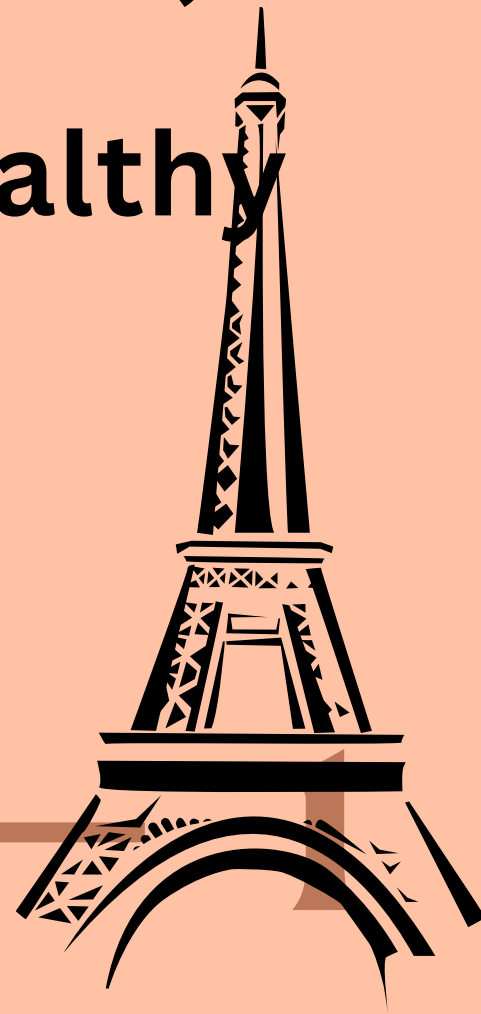
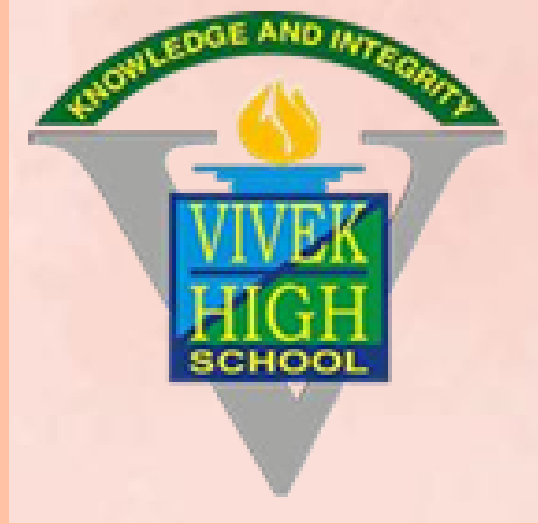

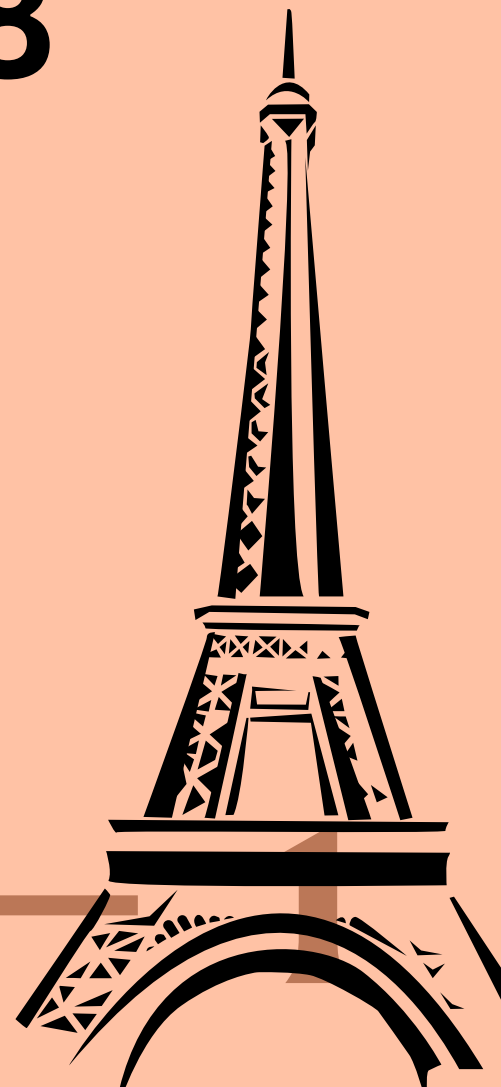

Event 1

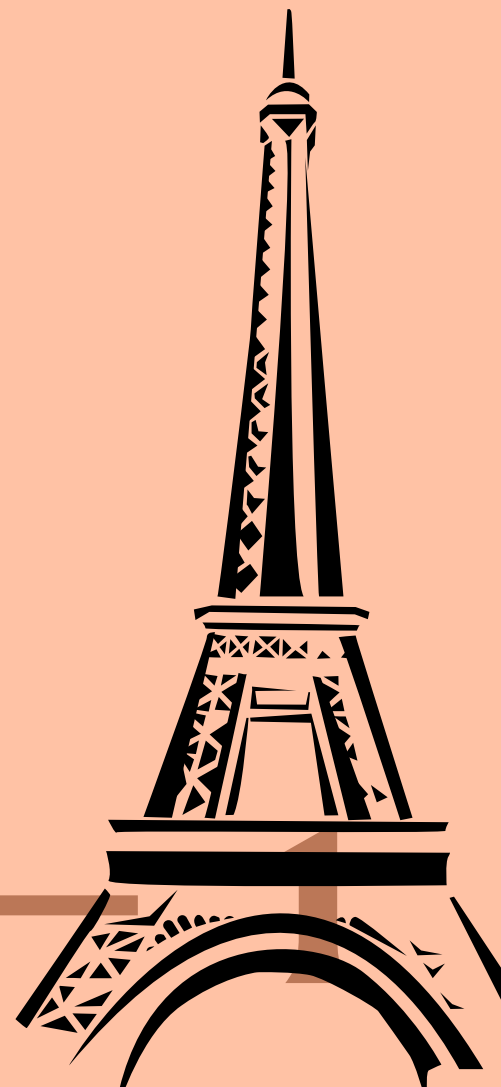
French Fashion Show for Classes 7 & 8



Rules and Guidance



- Each school should send two participants, one each from classes VII & VIII).
- Participants must come dressed as a famous French personality.
- Each participant will begin with a self-introduction (3–4 lines), followed by a 6–8 line presentation of a French personality.
- Each participant will be given a maximum of 2 minutes and must adhere strictly to the time limit.
- The first bell will be rung after 1 minute 30 seconds, and the final bell will be rung after 2 minutes.
- Language used must be French only.
- Use of PPT is not allowed.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.



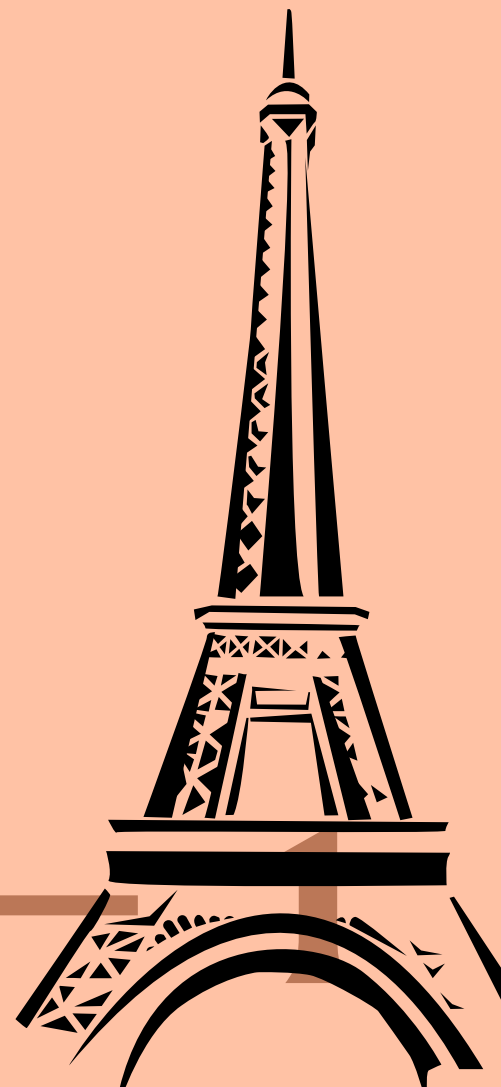

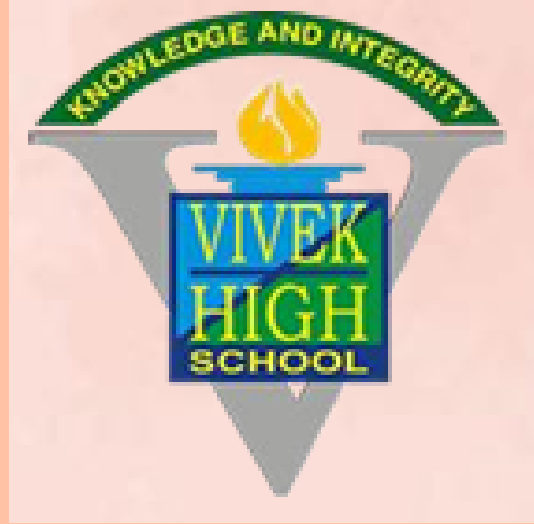

Judging will be based on the following criteria:

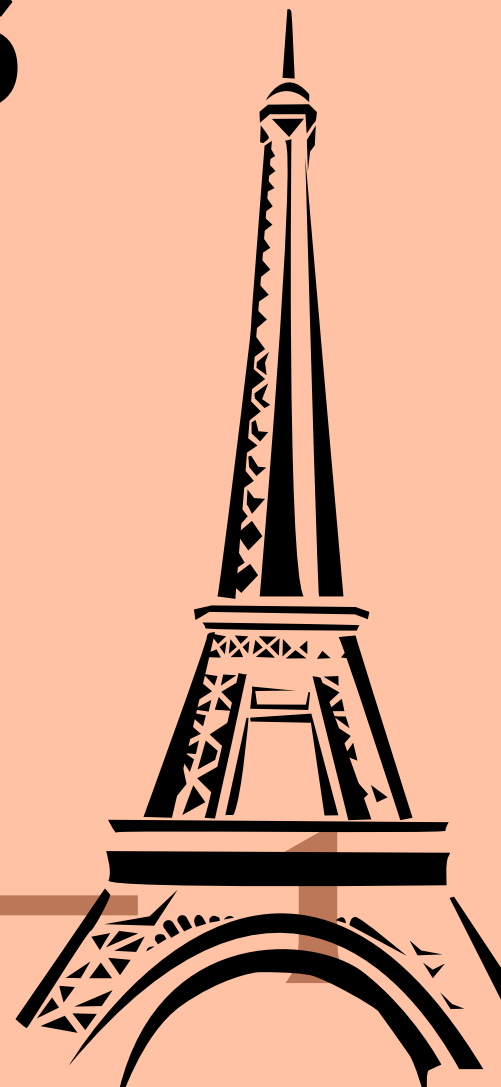
- **Costume & Creativity – 20 marks**

- **Total Marks - 100**



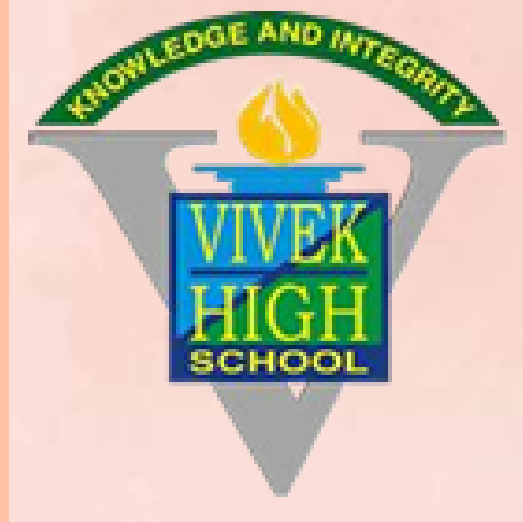


Event 2

Tambola in French for Classes 5 & 6

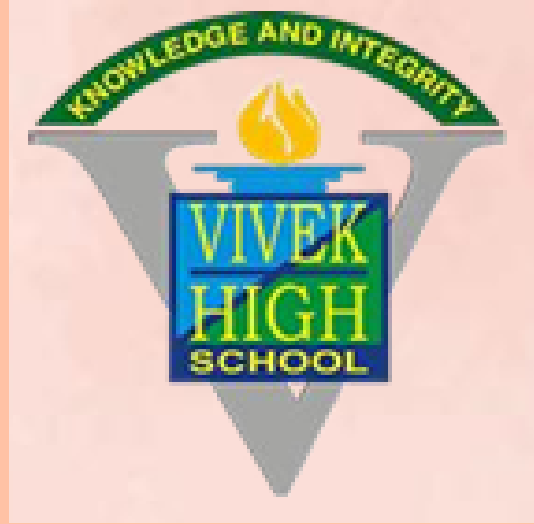


Rules and Guidance



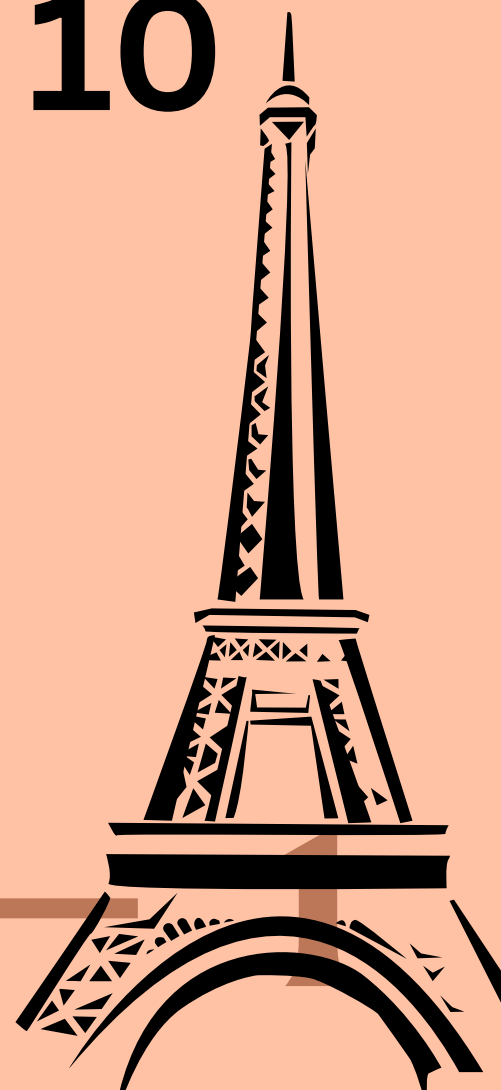
- Each school should send two participants, one each from classes V and VI.
- Participants will be provided with Tambola tickets containing numbers.
- The caller will announce numbers in French.
- Participants must listen carefully and identify and mark the correct numbers on their tickets.
- Only Full House will be considered for winning positions.
- The first three Full House winners will be awarded 1st, 2nd, and 3rd positions respectively.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.





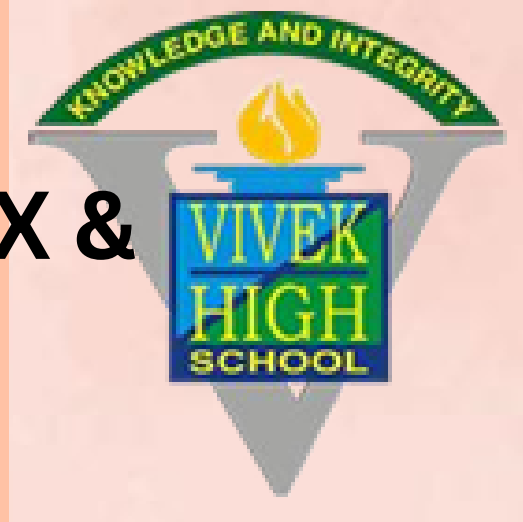

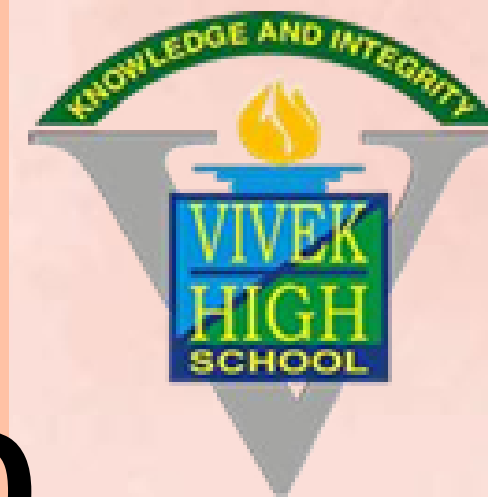
Storytelling in French for Classes 9 & 10



Rules and Guidance

- Each school should send two participants, one each from classes IX & X.
- The participant will narrate a story in French only.
- The story may be original or adapted from well-known English stories.
- The story should be presented in simple and clear French.
- Each participant will be given a maximum of 3 minutes and must adhere strictly to the time limit.
- The first bell will be rung after 1 minute, the second bell after 2 minutes, and the final bell at 3 minutes.
- Exceeding the time limit may lead to deduction of marks at the discretion of the judges.
- The use of PPT is not allowed.
- Participants are encouraged not to read the story, as excessive reading affects expression. They may refer to brief notes for support.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.





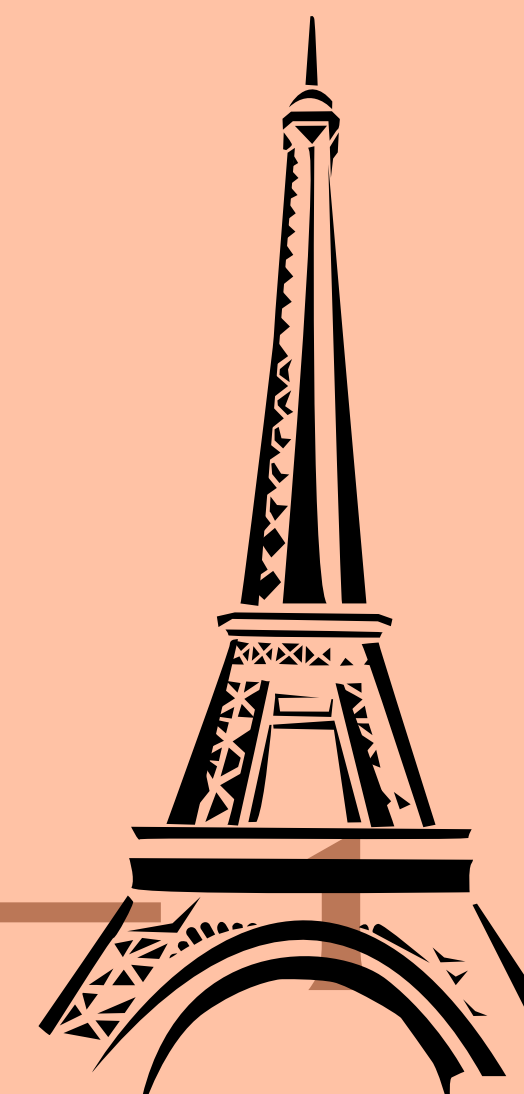

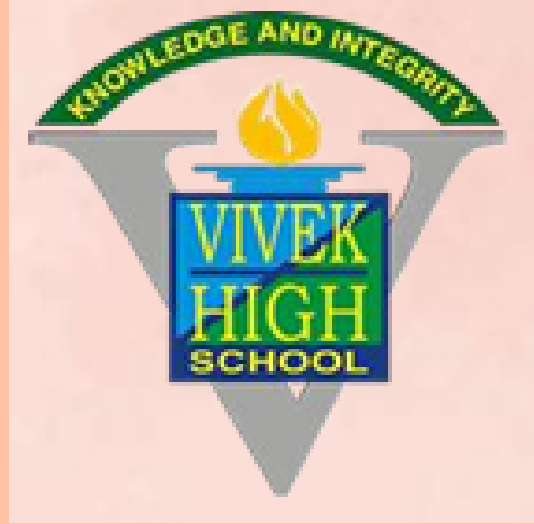
Judging will be based on the following criteria:
